Entries: Through SDMS online entry system, Link to register

Preliminary entry deadline "by Number" (for accommodation & team size): October 27, 2017.

Final entry "by Name" deadline: December 1, 2017.

Note that the WPNS points list is published on Dec 1. Athletes not registered by then will not be on the points list.

Eligibility: According to WPNS Rules

Competition fee: **20 Euro** per race according to the WPNS Competition Fee.

Visas: For those requiring a Visa to enter Canada, please apply early. We will be happy to assist you with a letter of invitation if needed. Simply send complete list of persons to the Competition Secretary. Visa information can be found at: www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/visas.asp

Submission of Visa Applications

Canada does not have a visa office in every country so it is important that delegates visit the website of the Canadian <u>visa office</u> responsible for processing their visa application. Information is available on the website on how to submit a visa application and the documentation required.

<u>Processing times for visa applications</u> vary depending on the visa office and the time of the year. Participants are encouraged to apply approximately **12 weeks** in advance of their departure date to ensure they receive the visa in time.

 This system allows clients to submit applications online. Delegates that choose to apply on-line will not have to submit their passport until requested to do so by a visa officer. 	 VACs are commercial service providers authorized by Canada to provide specific services to applicants. VACs provide a number of services to clients, including help applicants fill out forms, answer questions and ensure that applications are complete. 		
The visa office will send the applicant instructions on how and where to send their passports to finalize the visa process.	 Reduces unnecessary delays or refusals due to incomplete applications. VACs serve as a collection point for applicants required to provide a biometric. VACs send applications to visa offices and transmit decisions to applicants in a secure and confidential manner. VACs do not process visa applications and have no decision-making authority. 		

NEW - Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA)

As of November 10, 2016, visa-exempt foreign nationals are expected to have an <u>Electronic Travel</u> <u>Authorization</u> (eTA) to fly to or transit through Canada. <u>Exceptions</u> include U.S. citizens, and travelers with a valid Canadian visa. Canadian citizens, including dual citizens, and Canadian permanent residents are not eligible to apply for an eTA.

If you have any questions on the importation of goods related to your event please contact the <u>International Events and Conventions Services Program</u> (IECSP) at the <u>Canada Border Services</u> Agency (CBSA).

Anti-doping: Anti-doping to take place in accordance with IPC rules.

Waxing rooms: Space will be allocated to teams according to WPNS guidelines. Assignments & keys will be available in the Race Office starting 1 p.m. (1300 hours) *December 6th*. Keys will require a *\$370 CAD* deposit. Deposits will be returned upon the keys being handed back in to the race office. Available power is 110 volt a.c. A limited number of transformers are available to rent for **\$100 CAD** per entire event. These will supply 220 volt a.c. power.
