- Equipment checks found two incidents of goggles that did not meet specifications for the B1 category. These were rectified for the race.
- Please note that due to early season conditions parts of the course had limitations such as on width and these may limit opportunities like passing in certain areas.
- Training bibs should be worn on course at all times unless you are racing
- It was noted that several skiers double poled the complete course as no technical skiing zones were indicated. Ski associations are looking at this carefully for future competitions

General Information from the OC

- Parking restriction in the Biathlon parking lot were noted. If P1 (Biathlon) parking lot is full then cars must park in P2just above the Biathlon area. P1 drop off must be kept clear for emergency vehicles.
- Thanks for those that responded to their daily health assessments. These are not optional and must be answered each day.
