Course Preparation and Grooming

- There was a request that the tracks under the Biathlon Building Bridge be deepened as they were too shallow today and sit skiers popped out. Groomers will be notified.
- There was also a request to remove the tracks down hills if they were not going to be continuous and without wobbles. The response is that these tracks will be improved for the race tomorrow.
- A request was made to move the track to the outside of the course downhills. The response was that the convention for course is to place the track on the right side of the course regardless of whether that is inside or outside.

Range Information

- The lane assignments for tomorrow will be the same as today. The lane assignments will be reordered after tomorrows races.
- There will be spot checks on rifles
- The zone of silence will be extended 10 meters past the lanes as per requests
- The VI reset chips will be collected at the finish line with the athletes transponders.
- Should it be needed, there will be a holding or neutralizing zone and the times in and out will be tracked and passed on to timing.
- Please note that amplifications must be turned off in the shooting range. Voice and touch may be used instead.
