### General Information from the OC

Provide the location of the teams with the times desired. The lunches will arrive at best efforts at the time desired.
- Note that team lounges are not to be used for waxing.
- Please ensure that you have the parking passes that you need as parking will be restricted starting Saturday December 4.

- Teams requiring extra training bibs should contact Elke Gundermann she is working in the day lodge with classification.




